BYLAW NO.133/91

 $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$ BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF COLONSAY TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES.

The Council of the Town of Colonsay, in the province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purposes of this bylaw an "All terrain Vehicle" means a three or four wheeled vehicle built by a manufacturer primarily for the use of an all terrain vehicle. All other provisions of the "All Terrain Vehicle Act" apply.
- 2. The operator of the All Terrain Vehicle must have a valid Driver's License.
- 3. The owner of said All Terrain Vehicle must have valid Insurance on the All Terrain Vehicle as per section 14 of the All Terrain Vehicles Act.
- 4. A person is authorized to operate an All Terrain Vehicle on any street or alley within the corporate limits of the Town of Colonsay except on the highway access road north of the Skye Drive intersection.
- 5. It shall be lawful to operate an All Terrain Vehicle between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M. within the limits of the municipality.
- 6. The Council of the Town of Colonsay reserves the right to establish regulations regarding their All Terrain Vehicle Bylaw as they deem necessary.
- 7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval and signing such Bylaw.
