

BYLAW NO. 1/98

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follow:

Definitions:

"Vehicle" - means a vehicle as defined in The Highway Traffic Act.

1. The following water supply wells situated in the-
NE 21-34-27 W2
NE 21-34-28 W2
NE 12-34-29 W2
SW 34-35-28 W2
NE 12-36-28 W2
SE 36-36-28 W2 (1)
SE 36-36-28 W2 (2)

shall be designated as municipal wells for the purposes of providing residents with potable water.
2. Water obtained from municipal wells must immediately be placed in a holding tank and transported from the well site.
3. No person shall:
 - (a) wash or rinse off a vehicle at the site of a municipal well, and/or
 - (b) park a chemical spray apparatus or a vehicle that contains full or used chemical containers, pumps, hoses or other equipment used in conjunction with a chemical sprayer within:
 - (1) 100 metres of a municipal well, or a municipal water supply.
4. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the following penalties:
 - (a) First Offence-voluntary Payment of \$100.00
 - (b) Second and subsequent offences - mandatory court appearance and penalties as provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay will apply.
