A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF COLONSAY NO. 342
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF COLONSAY NO. 342 AND
THE MEACHAM & DISTRICT CEMETERY COMMITTEE TO PROVIDE
CEMETERY CARE.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement identified as Exhibit "A", with Meacham & District Cemetery Committee for the purpose of providing grass and weed maintenance for the Cemeteries.
Exhibit "A" is attached hereto and forms a part of this Bylaw.
2. The Reeve, James Gray and Administrator, Deborah Prosper of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached Agreement identified as Exhibit "A".

MEACHAM & DISTRICT CEMETERY CARE AGREEMENT

Between

R.M. of COLONSAY

And

ST. MARY'S ORTHODOX CHURCH/CEMETERY
ST. EDWARDS CEMETERY

ASCENSION OF OUR LORD PARISH - UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC CEMETERY

Upon purchase of a good quality lawn mower from money from the four cemeteries, the R.M. of Colonsay will have control of this lawn mower for the purpose of the grass and weed maintenance of the above four mentioned cemeteries. This lawn mower will be purchased solely for these cemeteries.

The R.M. of Colonsay will be then responsible for the general grass cutting duties of the cemeteries, including large areas and around the graves. The R.M. in agreement will be responsible for the service of the lawn mower, storage, insurance and manpower.

Minimum amount of times for the grass to be cut would be three (3) times per year and depending on weather conditions. Times, that we the committee for the cemeteries would like the grass to be cut would be maybe before "Mother's Day", and/or "Father's Day". Majority of the time it would be under the discretion of the R.M.. In case of special occasions, or if it seems that the grass needs cutting and is noted by one of the members of the cemetery committee, then we would let the R.M. Administrative office know. Also if something happens to get damaged or broken accidentally due to mowing, or other means, that the R.M. would let us know. (Example: if statues get broken due to rock chips flying from mower or whipper damage or any occurrence of vandalism, or if any repairs or obstructions or any modifications that they would like to be done to make their job easier ,etc).

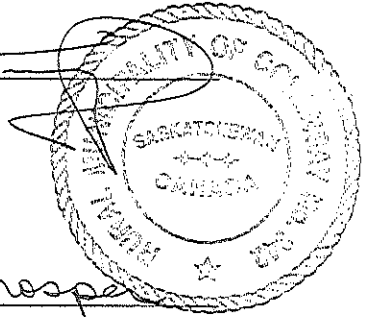
This agreement takes effect from this date AUGUST 13, 2003.
