
Bylaw No. 5/2002

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF COLONSAY NO. 342
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF COLONSAY NO. 342 AND
ALBERT CLAVELLE AND JOE CLAVELLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING
GRAVEL.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 is hereby authorized to enter into a 25 year Agreement identified as Exhibit "A", with Albert Clavelle & Joe Clavelle for the purpose of purchasing gravel.
Exhibit "A" is attached hereto and forms a part of this Bylaw.
2. The Reeve, James Gray and Administrator, Deborah Prosper of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached Agreement identified as Exhibit "A".

The Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342

-and-

Albert Clavelle of Viscount Saskatchewan

Joe Clavelle of North Battleford Saskatchewan

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 has agreed to purchase gravel from Albert Clavelle and Joe Clavelle and;

WHEREAS Albert Clavelle and Joe Clavelle have agreed to sell gravel to the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 subject to the terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth.

A 25 YEAR AGREEMENT TO BE AS FOLLOWS:

1. 10 Acres located on the Northeasterly portion of NW 08-34-25 W2nd to be fenced by Clavelle's and held for the sole use of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342.
2. That the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 equipment and Gravel Crushing equipment can enter the above property at the discretion of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342.
3. Gravel to be paid for after each crush at a rate of \$1.00 per yard.
4. Gravel crush piles to be measured by an independent agency at the expense of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342.
5. Gravel crush piles can be stored on the Northeasterly portion of NW 08-34-25 W2nd but crushed product is the property of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342.
