

SCHEDULE "A"
TO BYLAW NO. 2/2015
MUNICIPAL FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT
dated this 8th day of June, 2020.

BETWEEN:

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF COLONSAY No. 342

- and -

THE TOWN OF COLONSAY

1. The Councils of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No. 342 and the Town of Colonsay agree to jointly provide fire protection services, subject to the availability of fire fighters and equipment, to the residents of the municipalities' party to this agreement.
2. The Fire Department shall consist of volunteer fire fighters, and the fire chief shall be duly appointed yearly by resolution of the councils of the Rural Municipality of Colonsay No 342 and the Town of Colonsay.
3. The Fire Chief shall provide monthly reports and an annual written budget before the 28th day of February each year to the councils of both municipalities.
4. The Fire Chief shall complete and present fire incident reports to the Municipal Office within one week of the event.
5. The fire department shall respond to mutual aid calls as outlined in mutual aid agreements.
6. The parties to this agreement agree to share ½ and ½ in the costs and/or maintenance of:
 - a) The fire phones & radio equipment
 - b) The fire vehicles
 - c) The power & telephone at the fire hall
 - d) The equipment and supplies required for the operation of the fire department
 - e) Volunteer fire fighter's insurance
 - f) Volunteer fire fighter training & expenses
 - g) Volunteer fire fighter's remuneration as set by councils
7. The fees for service of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged to the owner of property on which the service is provided and charged as follows:
 - \$750.00 per hour
 - \$20.00/hr per fire fighter
 - \$0.50 per kilometer for use of fire fighters private vehicle
 - \$50.00 administration fee
 - False fire alarms – one false alarm callout per year at no charge; subsequent callouts \$200 within Town limits, \$300 within RM of Colonsay limits
 - Any required supplies at replacement cost
 - Fees collected for service shall be deposited into a fire equipment reserves account
8. This agreement shall continue until such time that either party wishes to terminate this agreement. At such time the party wishing to terminate this agreement shall give ninety (90) days notice in writing to the other party.
