WATER RATE INCREASE

******Due to an increase in costs to operate the water treatment plant (cost for chemical only increased by \$11,000 from 2021 to 2022), the Town has had to increase the water rates. The following rates were approved by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board:

Bi-Monthly Water Rates

4500 gallons or less Minimum - \$93.00

4,501 gallons and over \$15.00 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof Coin operated overhead fill \$15.00 per 1,000 gallons or part thereof

There is no change to the sewer rates \$50 – residential, \$82 – restaurants, motels, hotels

This rate increase is effective immediately.
