Pool Rule Reminders:

1. Respect to our guards and facility mandatory. Guards will not tolerate verbal or physical abuse. They have the right to ask any person to leave immediately.
2. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied IN the pool by someone at least 12 years of age.
⇒ Parents not in water do not need to pay admission.
3. A maximum of 2 children under 8 years old per 12-17 year old supervisor
4. Children in the Paddling Pool must be supervised at all times by someone who is at least 12 years old. This person **MUST** be in the FENCED Paddling Pool Area carefully watching child.
⇒ Please know that our paddling pool is under maintenance at this time and hope to open during the season
5. Swimmers must shower before entering the pool
6. All outside footwear must be removed prior to entering the change rooms. No outside footwear is permitted inside the fence; this includes spectators.
7. Clear the pool if the whistle is blown
8. No Glass or Peanuts permitted in the facility.
9. Proper *swimming* attire must be worn.
10. Feel free to bring CLEAN labelled pool toys. Water guns are not allowed.
11. Guards have the right to ask each swimmer to swim 4 widths of the pool before the swimmer enters the deep end. Those unable to complete the swim must stay in the SHALLOW end. This is for everyone's safety.
12. Children who are misbehaving may be asked to leave. Should the behavior persist they may be unable to return. Guards on duty have the discretion to enforce this.
