Colonsay Park (Golf Course) Revitalization Sponsorship Opportunities

The exciting project to revitalize the area of the old 9-hole golf course is well underway. The installation of the 18-hole Disc Golf course has started and expected to be completed by mid-September and ready to play. Over 70 trees, a mix of deciduous and coniferous, will be planted throughout the Disc Golf area of the park this fall. The Dog Park is planned to be constructed this fall and will include two fenced areas, one for small dogs and a larger area for big dogs (all dogs can access this fenced area!) Benches will be placed throughout the park and can be inscribed with memorial messages, family names and business names.
